

Download Minolta Manual Focus Cameras And Lenses

Early AUTO ROKKOR lenses, introduced in 1958 with the SR-2. With this line, the automatic diaphragm was introduced. If it's fully auto (re-opening directly after exposure) or semi-auto (diaphragm opens by operating film transport lever) is a feature of the camera, not the lens. Most cameras on this site are German cameras from the 1930s to 50s, but Japanese Minolta holds a special place in my collection. My first proper camera was a Minolta, a Dynax 500 SLR, as it was the most affordable at the time (mid 90s). Minolta Co., Ltd. (????, Minoruta) was a Japanese manufacturer of cameras, camera accessories, photocopiers, fax machines, and laser printers. Minolta was founded in Osaka, Japan, in 1928 as Nichi-Doku Shashinki Sh?ten (???????, meaning Japanese-German camera shop). It is perhaps best known for making the first integrated autofocus 35mm SLR camera system. There are many good reasons to adapt manual lenses to the Sony A7 series cameras. To do so you need an adapter and this article will help you to choose the right one. We are three guys from Germany who have adapted manual lenses for many years now.
